

9. Q&A

Q1: In junior high school, I have had a lot of absences, can I still enroll?

A1: Even if there are many days of absence, it is possible to take the high school entrance examination.

Acquire the basic academic skills for the academic achievement test. However, after entering the school, if there are too many absences, there is a possibility that you will not be able to graduate.

Q2: What are the elective subjects?

A2: There are many subjects that other schools don't have, and you can create your own timetable and study what you need for your future.

1. Series electives for studying specialized fields

Life and nature series (nature and environment, flowers, food science, introduction to fermentation, etc.)

Life and welfare series (clothing handicrafts, social life and welfare, food design, children's culture, etc.)

2. Free electives that match your desired course

(Life and English, light exercise and health, science information, etc.)

Q3: What is the difference between 3 year graduation course and 4 year graduation course?

A3: We aim to graduate in 3 years for the 3 year graduation course and 4 years for the 4 year graduation course. Students who aim to enter society early and become independent choose the 3-year course,

graduate in three years, and both those who go on to higher education and those who find employment go out into society and are active in their respective careers.

In the 3 year graduation course, students can graduate without taking external credits by taking A and B classes (15:40-17:10) three days a week for three consecutive years.

Q4: How many people are there in a class?

A4: The maximum number of applicants is 90 (3 classes with 30 students per class). Currently, there are 3 classes in the first year, with about 23 students per class. Our school is one of the largest of the night schools.

Q5: What are your plans after graduation?

A5: In the past few years, the number of people who found employment and those who went on to higher education are almost the same. Of the 64 graduates in 2019, 19 advanced to higher education and 25 found employment. After graduating, students are active in universities, vocational schools, and local companies.

Q6: What time do club activities start? Are there any club activities that participate in tournaments?

A6: Club activities are held from 21:00 to 21:50 after classes end. In addition to weekdays, there are club activities such as practice games with other schools on Saturdays and Sundays. The students are friendly

and work hard in the limited time. The men's and women's basketball club, soccer club, baseball club, tennis club, and judo club have a track record of participating in tournaments. The light music club also holds live performances on a regular basis.

Q7: Do you have school rules?

A7: In addition to observing social rules and manners such as violence and smoking, our school also has school rules for daily life. We strive to provide a safe and secure environment for our students. There are no school rules regarding clothing, hair, etc. Since there is no school uniform, students go to school in plain clothes.
