



Essential Points of Application for Admission in April 2023
(Exclusively for foreign student residing in Tokyo)

Tokyo Metropolitan Suginami Sogo High School

1. Application

20 foreign students residing in Tokyo will be admitted in April.
(Integrated studies program: 20 students)

2. Qualification

The applicant must:

-reside in Tokyo with guardian(s) not be enrolled in any of the following schools at the time of application to this school.

- Senior High School
- Senior High School for Special Needs
- Secondary Education of Integrated Junior / Senior High School
- High School Academy

-be registered as a foreign national.

-be born before April 1, 2008.

-satisfy one of the following three requirements.

- 1) The applicant must complete a 9-year course of school education abroad by the end of March, 2023.
- 2) The applicant must complete a 9-year course at an educational facility for foreign residents in Japan, which is equivalent to a 9-year course of Japanese compulsory education by the end of March 2023.
- 3) The applicant must complete the course of a Japanese junior high school by the end of March 2023.

In this case, it is also necessary that the applicant has lived in Japan for less than three years.

(Note)

Applicants or their guardian(s) should come to Tokyo Metropolitan Government Office at Shinjuku to confirm the qualification before submitting the application on the dates below:

Sun. December 4, 2022, from 10:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Sun. December 18, 2022, from 10:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

3. Application Submission

(a) Date

Mon. January 23, 2023, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Tue. January 24, 2023, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.

(b) Place

Tokyo Metropolitan Suginami Sogo High School

※The application should be delivered to the school office by hand.

(Applications by mail are not accepted)

※No correction is to be made once the application has been submitted.

(c) Required Form and Procedures

(1) The Application Form

(2) The certificate of the academic record of the applicant's last school year

This document must contain a certification that the applicant has satisfactorily completed a 9-year course of school education abroad.

The substitute certifications should be written in Japanese or English. Certifications written in neither Japanese nor English must be translated into Japanese by a public institution or a translation agency and so on.

(3) ① or ②

① "Juminhyo kisaijiko shomeisho (Certificate of residence)" of the applicant (see 「様式応3」), issued by a municipal office in the applicant's residential area, or the equivalent.

② The certificate issued by a public agency which certifies that the applicant has a foreign nationality.

(4) The form of entry date

The applicant qualified by 2. Qualification 3) is required to submit the form in which the date of entry into Japan is recorded.

(5) The applicant's personal history (see 「様式杉総外国－1 PERSONAL HISTORY パーソナル・ヒストリー」) Please refer to the example on the form.

(6) Certificate of Meeting Qualification Requirements

(7) "Riyusho"

In the case that the applicant's guardians are his/her parents, if one of the guardians cannot live with the applicant in Tokyo due to special circumstances, the applicant needs to clarify the reason and submit Reason Statement (理由書「様式応7」) to be examined. It is not necessary for an applicant who is in a junior high school in Tokyo to submit this form.

(8) "Nyukokunikansuru Moushitatesho"

Applicants who are living overseas and will move to Tokyo with their parents are required to submit this form.

(9) Extra forms are required for applicants who

-do not live in Tokyo now but are sure to move to Tokyo by the date of the entrance ceremony.

-live in Tokyo but attend a school outside Tokyo

Please ask for these forms at the school office.

(10) Those who prefer examination question sheets with "hiragana" printed above each "kanji" should submit the special arrangement request form (see 「様式30」) supplied in this booklet. The principal's name is not necessary for applicants who do not attend or have not graduated from a junior high school in Japan.

(11) Entrance Examination Fee

Applicants are required to pay ¥2,200 after December 1, 2022 to the specified banks or post offices as listed on the back of the payment form put in this booklet.

The Receipt of the fee has to be attached to the back of the Application Form and to be shown at the time of the application.

4. Examinations

1) Examination Subjects

Composition and interview either in Japanese or English
(Prior to submitting, choose either Japanese or English)

2) Date

Thu. January 26, 2023, at 8:30 a. m. The exact timetable is shown on the Admission Ticket.
Guardian(s) MAY NOT come to the school on that day.

3) Test Site

Tokyo Metropolitan Suginami Sogo High School

5. Announcement of Successful Applicants

1) Date and Place

9:00 a.m. Thu. February 2, 2023 at Tokyo Metropolitan Suginami Sogo High School

2) Notification to the Successful Applicants

A certificate will be given to the applicant or the guardians within the period stated below

9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Thu. February 2, 2023

9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon on Fri. February 3, 2023

at the school office

6. Entrance Formalities

Successful applicants are expected to complete the "School Entrance Agreement Form" within the period stated below to conclude the entrance formalities:

9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Thu. February 2, 2023

9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon on Fri. February 3, 2023

Those who have not completed the entrance formalities within the period mentioned above will be regarded as having abandoned their acceptance into the school.

The school Entrance Agreement Form is invalid if the School Entrance Fee of ¥5,650 is not paid.

The payment deadline is specified in the certificate of acceptance (Gokaku-tsuchisho).

7. Other Matters

1) Applicants who do not comply with the Application Qualifications, or have failed to complete and present all the necessary forms, or have given false statements, will be disqualified even if they had been accepted to Suginami Sogo High School.

2) Students who successfully pass the examination cannot apply to be admitted to any other Tokyo Metropolitan High School.

3) Those who pass this entrance examination, even if they do not complete the entrance formalities, in the end, cannot apply for the entrance examination of another Tokyo Metropolitan High School.

4) Almost all the classes at Suginami Sogo High School are taught in Japanese.
