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②Three-Part System

You can choose a part(部) when you apply.



A typical three part system

Morning class

Afternoon class

Night class

③Part-time system but similar to full-time system

- 5 days a week, 6 hours a day
- You can graduate in 3 years
- 30 people in one class × 6 classes
(Ⅰ部: 2 classes Ⅱ部: 2 classes Ⅲ部: 2 classes)
- You can study Japanese, English, and mathematics in small groups of 10 to 20 students.



- We promote **out-of-class activities** and **volunteer activities**
- **Frequent use of ICT**
(DX high school, Generative AI pilot school)
- **Club activities** and **events**
(sports competitions, cultural festivals, school trips) are active
- There are uniforms and school rules.

- After school, students can study for classes, the JLPT (Japanese Language Proficiency Test), and career paths in special classes.

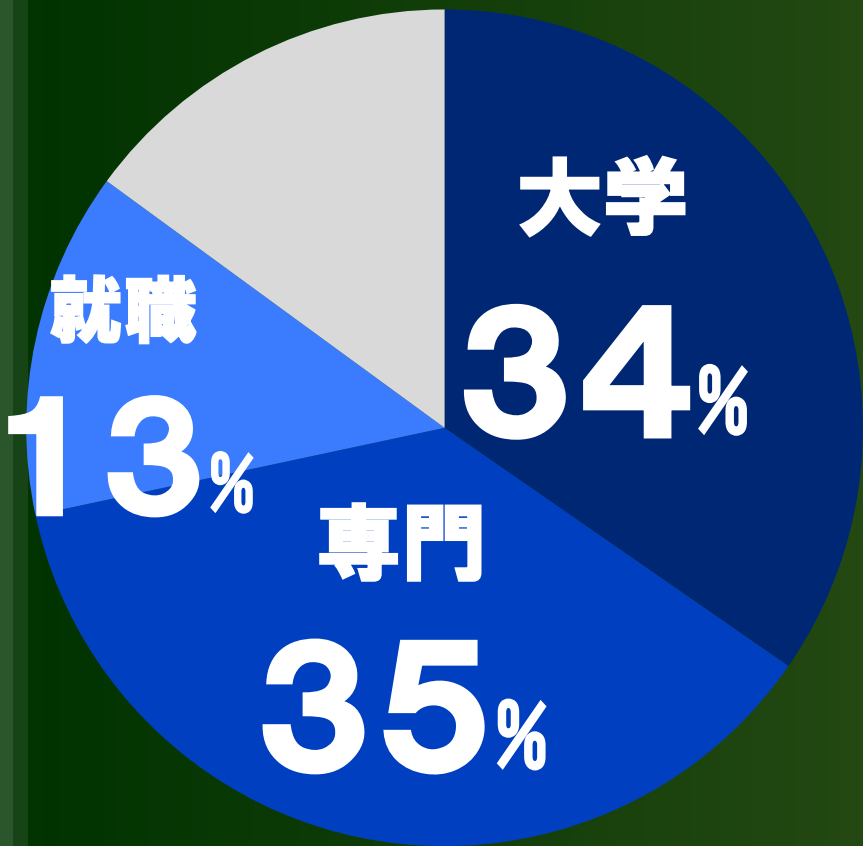

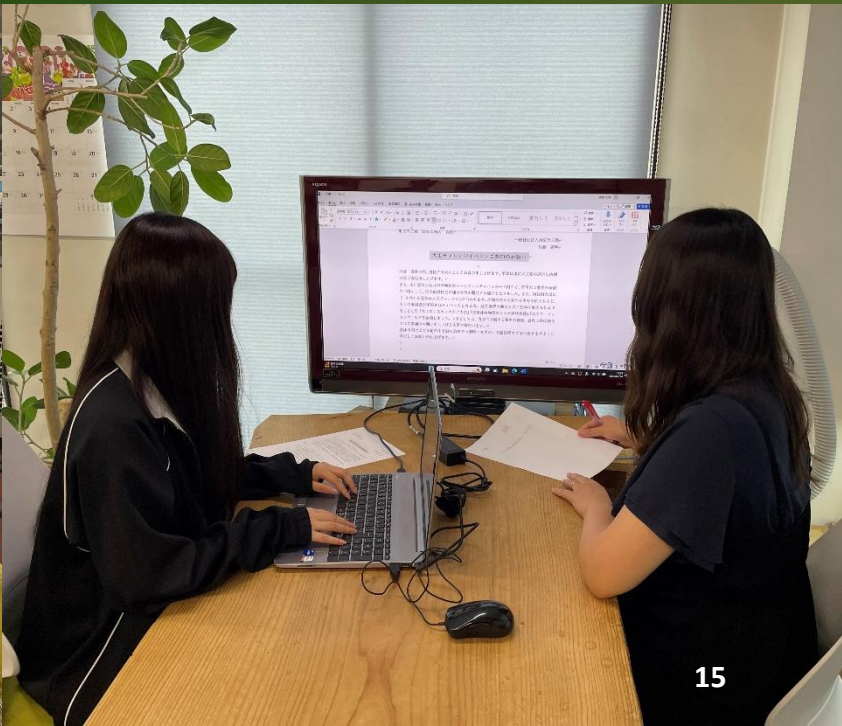

Special Entrance Examination

for Foreign Tokyo Students

- Those who have graduated from a Japanese junior high school, regardless of nationality, **and have been in Japan for less than 3 years (those who entered Japan on or after January 1, 2022)**
- Those who are scheduled to complete or have completed a 9-year course abroad, regardless of nationality.
- Those with foreign nationality who are scheduled to complete or have completed a 9-year course at a foreign school in Japan.

Date : Sunday, January 26th

Content:

1 Essay (Japanese or English) 50 min 400pts.

2 Interview (Japanese or English) 200pts.

3 Academic Report from your previous school
100pts.

Number of people:

20 students to be admitted (only I部&II部)

Qualification Screening

You cannot take the exam unless you have your eligibility verified.
