



for Foreign Tokyo Students

- Those who have graduated from a Japanese junior high school, regardless of nationality, and have been in Japan for less than 3 years (those who entered Japan on or after January 1, 2022)
- Those who are scheduled to complete or have completed a 9-year course abroad, regardless of nationality.
- Those with foreign nationality who are scheduled to complete or have completed a 9-year course at a foreign school in Japan.

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Date: Sunday, January 26th

Content:

- 1 Essay (Japanese or English) 50 min 400pts.
- 2 Interview (Japanese or English) 200pts.
- 3 Academic Report from your previous school 100pts.

Number of people:

20 students to be admitted (only I部&II部)

You cannot take the exam unless you have your eligibility verified.
