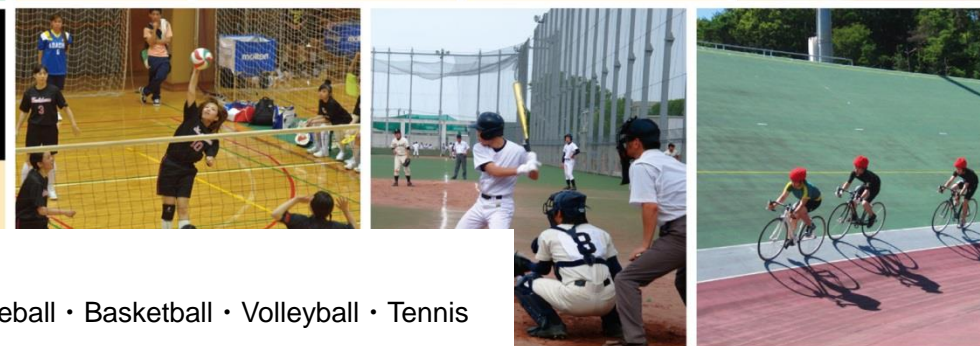

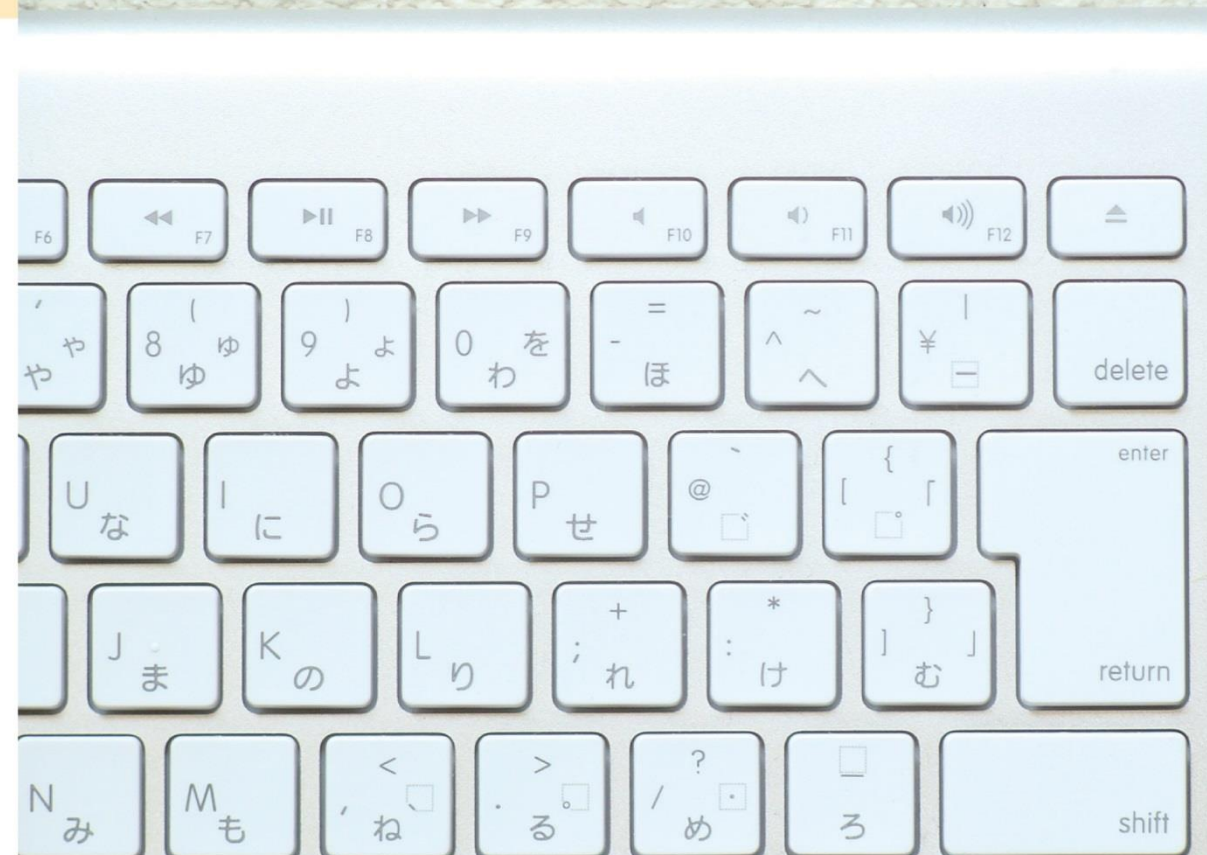

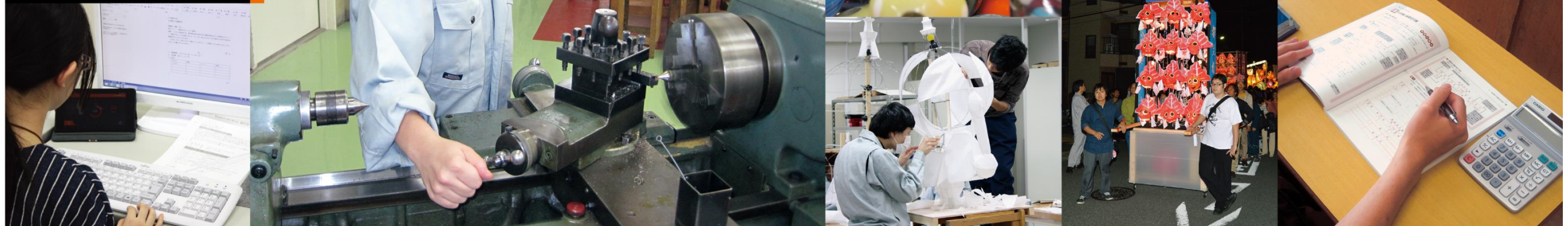

# The FIRST Industrial High School at night in Japan

## Curriculum

While studying business and industry, students pursue their goals for employment or higher education.



### Subjects in Business area

To acquire abilities to do proper accounting in real business, students gain knowledge and skill to utilize computer effectively. Studying the system of economic society, laws and basic business manners, students learn how to pass license exams.

### Subjects in Artisans area

Students study to make "Things that can be sold in the market" by their own hands with responsibility. With materials such as paper, metal, wood, leather or glass, they learn wide variety of processing technology using drafting tools, lathe or welding machines. Consciousness to make products in good faith will be enhanced.

### General subjects

Through the general subject areas that we provide, students learn the necessary academic skills that they will need in society. Through studying liberal arts like Japanese, arithmetic, social studies, scientific study, health, P.E., dietary education and home economics, they study the foundations of life.

**4-year course:** Utilize daytime for fulfilling lifestyle or  
**3-year course:** Academic top priority and go out in the world one year earlier.  
Choose one during the 1<sup>st</sup> year.

The nearest graduation is 3 years ahead.

There is a 3 year course option.

You can choose 3-year course or usual 4-year course depending on your lifestyle. You must pass several qualification exams added to ordinary classes to graduate in 3 years.



## "Manufacturing" or "Business" course?

Category type selection system is introduced to develop specialists. You will study both "manufacturing" and "business" during 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> years. From the 3<sup>rd</sup> year, one of two courses must be chosen.
