

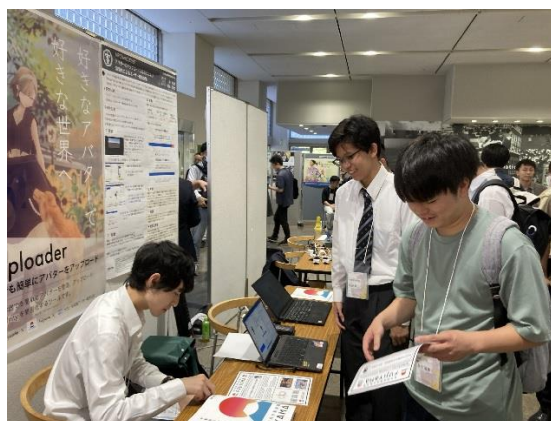
29th Annual Conference (2024) of the Virtual Reality Society of Japan
